

INFORMATION CLAUSE FOR PARTICIPANTS OF THE ONLINE EVENT

"MASTERCLASS HOMO ROBOTICUS" (21.10)

1. The organizer of the event is the National Creativity Center Foundation with its seat in Warsaw at ul. Niepodległości 233/1, 02-087 Warsaw, entered by the District Court for the capital city of Warsaw in Warsaw, XIII Commercial Division of the National Court Register under the number KRS 0000102389, NIP: 1181637143, REGON: 015154119.

2. A participant of the event is any natural person who participates in the event (hereinafter referred to as the "Participant").

3. It is possible that the course of the event, including the image of people participating in it, will be recorded using video and sound recording devices.

4. By signing up for the event, the participant agrees to the processing of personal data, including name and surname, telephone number and e-mail address. At the same time, by participating in the event, the Participant agrees free of charge to use, including disseminating by the National Creativity Center Foundation, his image, recorded during the event using image and sound recording devices, by publishing it in whole or in part on social profiles (including . facebook, youtube) and websites of the National Creativity Center Foundation and entities cooperating with it in the implementation of its statutory objectives, as well as in publications, presentations, film materials, and other information materials from the National Creativity Center Foundation or commissioned by it (also in printed and electronic versions) distributed by the National Creativity Center Foundation in connection with the organization of the event or related information or promotion activities.

5. Pursuant to Art. 13 sec. 1 and 2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (Journal UE L 119/1 of 04/05/2016), hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR", I would like to inform you that:

a) The administrator of the Participants' personal data is the National Creativity Center Foundation with its registered office in Warsaw at ul. Niepodległości 233/1;

b)) The administrator has appointed the Personal Data Protection Inspector; contact to the DPO: Wiktor Rybicki: wiktor.rybicki@ctn.org.pl; 3) the Participant's personal data will be processed in order to record, prepare and organize the event, and in the case of personal data in the form of an image, in order to inform in the media and in publications about the Administrator's activities - pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. a GDPR, i.e. separate consent referred to in point. 4 above;

c) recipients of the Participants' personal data will be entities authorized to obtain personal data on the basis of separate legal provisions, authorized employees / associates of the Administrator, providers of technical and organizational services, and entities entrusted with the processing of personal data by the Administrator - with all guarantees ensuring the security of the data provided; 5) Participants' personal data in the form of an image will be transferred to third countries (outside the European Economic Area), for which the European Commission has issued a decision on the appropriate level of personal data

protection; in such cases, the data will be transferred in accordance with generally applicable provisions of law with appropriate safeguards, based on standard clauses

data protection adopted by the European Commission; The participant may obtain a copy of the personal data transferred to a third country; other personal data will not be transferred to the recipient in a third country or an international organization;

d) Participants' personal data will be stored until consent is revoked;

e) Participants have the right to access their data and the right to rectify, delete, limit processing, the right to transfer data, the right to object, the right to withdraw consent at any time without affecting the lawfulness of the processing that was carried out on the basis of consent before its withdrawal;

f) Participants have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body - the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, if the Administrator violates the provisions on the protection of personal data while processing personal data;

g) Providing personal data is voluntary, but necessary to participate in the Event;

h) No automated decisions will be made towards the Participants (decisions without human intervention), including their data will not be subject to prof.
